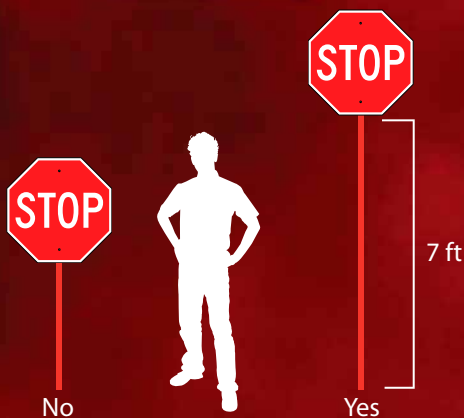


# Simplifying New Traffic Sign Regulations For Public & Private Property

## Mounting



Mount sign 7 ft to the bottom of the sign

## Street Name Signs



Where the speed limit is 25 mph or less  
Use 6" high sign with 4" high letters

Where the speed limit is over 25 mph  
Use 9" high signs with 6" letters

## New Required Reflectivity Levels

*For Parking Signs*  
Use Engineer Grade Reflective Film



*For Any Traffic Control Or Street Name Sign*  
Use High Intensity Prismatic Reflective Film

## Effective Now

If the public travels on property that you own or manage, your traffic signs, pavement marking, and other traffic control devices are now required to conform to the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD). That includes privately owned property where the public travels. Examples are shopping centers, office and apartment complexes,, and even recreation facilities.
